Work is now underway on the redevelopment of Muirhouse Shopping Centre.

A new pedestrian walkway has been created through the existing centre to maintain access to the following premises which all remain **OPEN FOR BUSINESS AS USUAL**:-

Muirhouse Library

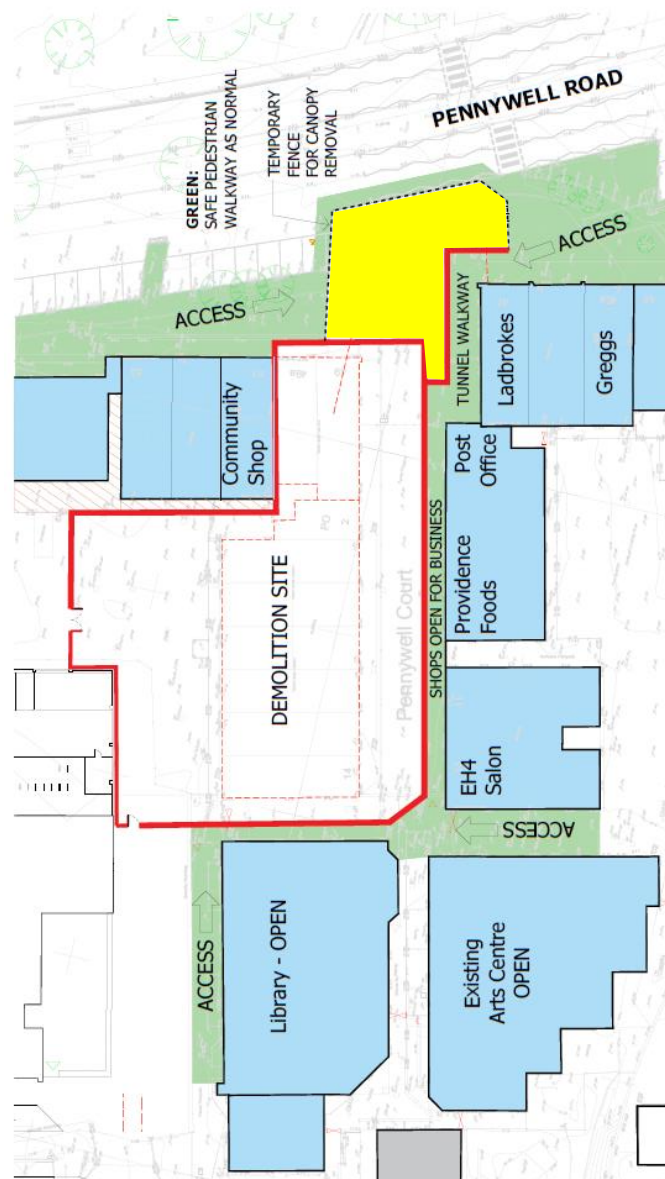

The first phase of demolition is underway. Over the next month the shopping centre roof will be removed and the side of the mall containing the former baba's cave etc will be demolished.

The main steel canopy which projects out towards Pennywell Road is planned to be demolished on the weekend of 21st/22nd October 2017. From week commencing 16 October the area of the canopy will be fenced off as shown in yellow on the attached map then removed once the canopy work is complete. The former site of The Gunner Pub will follow on quickly and be demolished by Nov 2017.

These demolitions are required to make way for construction of 12 new flats and 3 new retail units which is the first phase of the wider plans to create a total of 148 new homes, 13 new retail units and community facilities around a new public area. Construction is phased over the next few years to help reduce disruption.
