A90 Burnshot Bridge

Introduction

This note provides an update to Progress Update No 15, dated 26th April 2019.

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Speed Limits

Safety of the construction workers is the #1 priority for the entire project team, and hence the first topic of this briefing. A 50mph speed limit has been introduced on the A90 Southbound carriageway between Dolphington and Burnshot, and is in addition to the North and Southbound 40mph limits which are already in place.

ALL drivers are asked to respect these speed limits, which are in place for the safety of the workers, working to build infrastructure to improve your journey each day. Police Scotland are aware of the importance of these controls and various measures are being introduced to address the concern of speeding motorists.

Construction of Burnshot Bridge

Construction of the bridge commenced as programmed. The Contractor, Balfour Beatty is progressing well and the new bridge is due to be opened in Spring 2020.

Since site clearance works began on 1st May, the contractor has:

- Demolished the remaining existing abutments and foundations from the old bridge.
- Excavated to foundation sub-formation level (2.5m below road level) on both sides of the road.
- Placed 1m deep compacted structural fill to support the foundations.
- Placed 70mm deep blinding concrete to form a level surface for foundation construction.
- Constructed the 20m long x 5m wide x 0.8m deep reinforced concrete foundations, which were poured on 9th and 23rd July.
- Constructed the reinforced concrete columns which will support the capping beam. The West columns was poured on 19th July and the East columns were poured on 1st August.
- Installed the 'manhole sleeves' over the West columns which will contain the reinforced soil and allow the bridge to move under thermal expansion/contraction and vehicular loading.
- Commenced the installation of the reinforced soil abutment facing blocks.
- Commenced drainage installation.


